Covid 19 Requirements

- Masks covering the nose and mouth will be required at all times on the show grounds. We suggest bringing multiple masks of varying thickness to accommodate a variety of situations or conditions. Masks will be available at the show.
- Attendees not complying with these requirements will be subject to a Bench Show Hearing

COVID-19 Guideline and Requirements

Shared Responsibilities

Fiesta Dog Show is embracing a "Shared Responsibilities" concept. However, this happens when we work together with a combined effort from all.

A minimum of 72-hour notice will be given to all exhibitors of the date and time this show will open for entries.

Prepare for a variety of changes. Rawhide Event Center is on Tribal Land. We must follow tribal law and respect their sovereign rights.

The following guidelines and policies will be in effect at this show.

Mask, properly worn, will be required 100% of the time while on the show grounds unless inside your RV. Masks must be worn under face shields.

If you cannot or will not wear a mask 100% of the time, while on Rawhide Event Center property. DON'T COME.

If you are troubled with the current environment. DON'T COME

There will be six foot social distancing at all times inside and out the ring.

Each ring will have six foot markings.

Daily temperature checks are required for all exhibitors. After a daily successful temperature check, you will receive a colored wristband.

All attendees must wear the daily, correctly colored band while on Rawhide grounds.

There will not be any dryers, of any type allowed indoors.

Blow drying is only allowed at Reserved Carside Grooming and RV/Box Truck Spaces.

Rawhide is a NO hug or handshake zone.

Bring your own pens, no sharing.

No public catalogs at ringside, vendors or Superintendents tables.

Judges may be digitized into professional photos.

Tribal police, Event Security and the Event Committee will enforce the Tribes' mask policy. Non-compliance is a benchable offense.

There will be NO AKC reinstatement for disqualified dogs.

Entrance Protocols

Temperature will be done at the gate on everyone.

The RV site will have a temperature check station open from 6:00 am to 8:00 am daily. Wristbands will be provided.

Reserved parking with space for a popup tent will be provided. Please see reserved grooming for details.

Please allow extra time to enter show grounds.

Ring Protocols—Shared Responsibilities

You must wear a mask at all times, covering your nose and mouth.

Entrance tables will be provided for self-pick-up of armbands.

Exhibitor will show bites, be prepared.

Provide/bring your own chair, none will be provided.

Maintain 6 foot spacing.

One entrance, one exit, clearly marked, no waiving, when finished please leave

Ribbons/rosettes will be readied on a separate exit table.

Know your dog's number.

General Protocols—Shared Responsibilities:

Please bring and use your own scoops and or bags for poop clean up. This includes cleaning up in the walks to and from the rings.

Please wash hands with soap and water as often as practical.

Please be self-sufficient and responsible; bring enough masks and hand sanitizer to last through four or five days of shows.

Superintendents Table—Shared Responsibilities

Social distancing will be the new normal.

Do not reach under the plexiglass.

Forms available per request (move ups etc.)

Vendors and Concessions—Shared Responsibilities

Social distancing will be the new normal.

This is a no contact zone.

Please avoid the urge to handshake, fist bump, or high five.

Masks may be dropped when seated and while eating or drinking.

Temperature checks and 100% mask compliance is not negotiable.

Dealing with sickness at event--Shared Responsibilities.

Event Staff, Exhibitors, and Vendors will self assess daily, and have temperature checked upon entering grounds, or on RV grounds.

Event Staff, Exhibitors and Vendors must notify Show Committee if they have symptoms.

If symptoms are present, you will be asked to leave the event.

Do Not Come, if you are showing symptoms of acute respiratory illness, consistent with COVID-19—such as fever, cough, chills, muscle pain, headache. Sore throat or shortness of breath, that cannot be explained by a previous medical or allergic condition

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level compeon for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC Naonal Owner-Handled Series compeon during the enr e show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisng a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may parcipa te in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

★ A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition counts as one win towards moving to Open.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs seven (7) years or older.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

The above classification is provided for all breeds (and varieties). Additional divisions, i.e. (age, color or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry.

SALUKI SUPPORTED ENTRY - SUNDAY

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - Two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owner and both dogs must be entered in another class.

GROOMING & SET-UPS - Grooming areas are designated and supervised by the Fiesta Dog Shows, and/or their designated agents, who will be available to assist and enforce the set-up starting Thursday at 8:00 am, both indoors and outdoors. Guards will be on duty Thursday - Sunday and on the days of the shows, but the Fiesta Dog Shows cannot be responsible for any personal property left unattended on the show grounds.

RESERVED GROOMING - Reserved grooming spaces, without power, will be offered to all exhibitors. This is for the convenience of the exhibitors to allow those with reservations to arrive at the venue at any time after 8:00 am on Thursday with the assurance of adequate set-up space. Outdoor Reserved Grooming will be available at 8:00 am on Thursday. Please see the reserved grooming section of the premium list for details and restrictions. All crates, chairs and equipment must remain within the limits of the designated space. **NO FORCE or BLOW DRYERS IN RESERVED GROOMING SPACES. ONLY AT CAR-SIDE GROOMING AND RVs.**

PUBLIC GROOMING SPACE -This will be available only in the non-reserved parking area at carside.

PERSONAL SET-UPS (EZ ups, canopies, equipment and tents, etc) - are permitted in designated areas. No set-ups will be permitted within twenty feet of any ring. No crates, exercise pens, grooming tables, or set-ups will be permitted in the aisles. **The Fiesta Dog Shows are Not Responsible For Loss Or Injury Due To Tenting Not Provided By The Fiesta Dog Shows.**

RING ENTRY SHADE TENTS - RINGSIDE CRATING - The shade tents at ringside are for the convenience of the exhibitors while their breed is being exhibited. It is expected that exhibitors will occupy the shaded area no sooner than fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled exhibition time, or later than five minutes after completion of their breed judging. Dogs may be left unattended ringside ONLY while that breed is in the ring being judged. Owners or agents who violate these regulations, will be subject to disciplinary action as exacted by the Show Committee.

DOGS LEFT IN PARKED CARS - IN THE EVENT THAT IT BECOMES NECESSARY TO RESCUE AN ANIMAL FROM A PARKED CAR ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR PARKING AREAS IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDING THE SHOW GROUNDS, THE FIESTA DOG SHOWS WILL NOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF RESCUING THE ANIMALS. FURTHERMORE, IF THE RESCUE HAS TO BE PERFORMED BY VIRTUE OF NEGLIGENCE, THE OWNER, AGENT OR ANY OTHER PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE RESCUED ANIMAL WILL BE SUBJECTED TO AN EVENT COMMITTEE HEARING, AS APPROVED BY THE RULES OF THE AKC.

FIESTA DOG SHOWS PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Effective immediately, the following Show Photography Policy is in effect.

Official Photographer: Like all shows, we have OFFICIAL contracted photographers listed in our Premium List. Only the OFFICIAL photographer is permitted to take "win" photos. NO ONE is permitted to take "win" photos "over the shoulder" of the official photographer or use the designated "win" photography photo stand for photos. A separate "public use" photo stand will be available.

Amateur Photographer: As an amateur photographer you are welcome to photograph this event. You are always welcome to take photographs of your own dog, provided you are not

interfering with the official photographer.

Contractual and Spec photographers will check in at the Informaon Booth on the show site Thursday or Friday morning to receive/provide forms and pay any applicable fees. EXPRESS WRITTEN PERMISSION of the Show Chair, or their designee is required prior to taking any photographs on the show site. At that me the appropriate official idenfication will be provided before photographing will begin.

Contractual Photographer: If you have been hired to take photographs of dogs, you must not y the Show Chair to this fact.

Spec/Candid/Ring-Side Photographer: If you are shoong unsolicited photographs of dogs that you will later offer for sale through your own website, FaceBook, etc, the same rules apply as above. Photographers who are hired by publicaons to take photographs are considered to be Spec Photographers. If you were hired directly by a specialty club, the same rules apply as above.

Info: Please refer to the official Fiesta Dog Shows website for appropriate contacts and forms. Whether or not wri en permission is granted will be based on various criteria, including but not limited to exisng agreements with the Official Photographer(s), and the payment of a vendor fee. (All vendors will be listed on our website.) The vendor fee for Contractual and Spec Photographers is \$20.00 a day or \$50.00 for the weekend. Photographers not in compliance with this policy will be asked to leave the show grounds. Any photographs taken at our show and offered for sale without permission will be considered the property of the Fiesta Dog Shows.

The Scosdale Dog Fanciers Associaon, Inc. & the Arrowhead Kennel Club do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

No dogs that are disqualified for aggression will be allowed to enter these Shows, nor be allowed to be on the grounds. In addition, no aggression reinstatement procedures will be performed at these Shows.

No reinstatements will be allowed at these shows or on the show grounds.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Lagotti Romagnoli, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeens, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breed may be judged on a ramp or on a table: Mudi

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows and Keeshonden.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 4) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entries received prior to the published opening date and time of entries or received prior to the publishing of this premium list will be returned without processing.

A service/processing fee of \$7.00 will be charged to each duplicate entry.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.50 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify the Superintendent of any change of address.

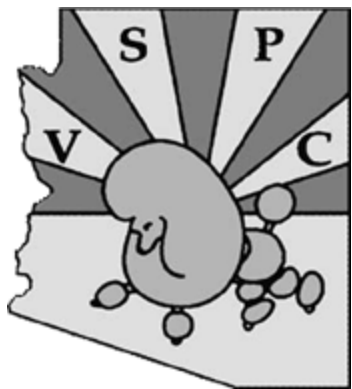
